## Can anyone visit the field?

We love sharing our sport with the public! Everyone is welcome.

## Should I bring my kids?

Your children are welcome but understand that we have no attractions for them. You will need to bring toys for them and have a responsible adult to supervise them at all times. You can't hear a glider landing and the safety of your children is paramount.

## What facilities do you have?

We have a modern club house with an elevated deck that provides a great view of the field. There are flush toilets, a refrigerator with soft drinks for sale, and a large room to get out of the sun.

## What should I bring with me?

- A **hat and sunglasses** for everyone in your party. There is limited shade at any glider club.
- **Liquids** (water, pop, Gatorade ...) to keep you hydrated. There are some liquids for sale in the club house refrigerator.
- **Food** (sandwiches, fruit, snacks ...) especially if you are staying over noon.
- **Appropriate clothing**. It's surprising how much colder it can be on an open field with a brisk wind. Extra clothing can be left in your vehicle but can't be worn if left at home.
- **Sun screen**. We always fly on sunny days!
- **Folding chairs** for each of you. Optional but advisable.
- **Cash**. Cash is preferred. We usually can accept credit cards at the field, but not debit cards. We can also accept payment by Interac eMail transfer.

## What should I leave at home?

- A **pet** requires a lot of your attention and, if it gets free, can be very dangerous on an airfield.

## What do I do when I get there?

- Park your vehicle in the gravel area between the hangar and the clubhouse building. Avoid parking on grass.
- Let us know that you are here. Introduce yourself to a member or use the walkie talkie on the picnic table by the hangar to contact us at the flight line or phone the flight line **519-661-7844**
- Feel free to use the club house facilities, including the bathroom.
- Walk or hitch a ride on a golf cart to the flight line. Always walk on the edge of the field on the hangar side of the field.
- If anyone in your party must have a ride to the flight line, we will use the golf cart to help. You can purchase a **Day Membership** which includes an introductory flight. See website for details.
